At the very outset, I feel happy to say that NSS is successful in shaping the personality of our students.



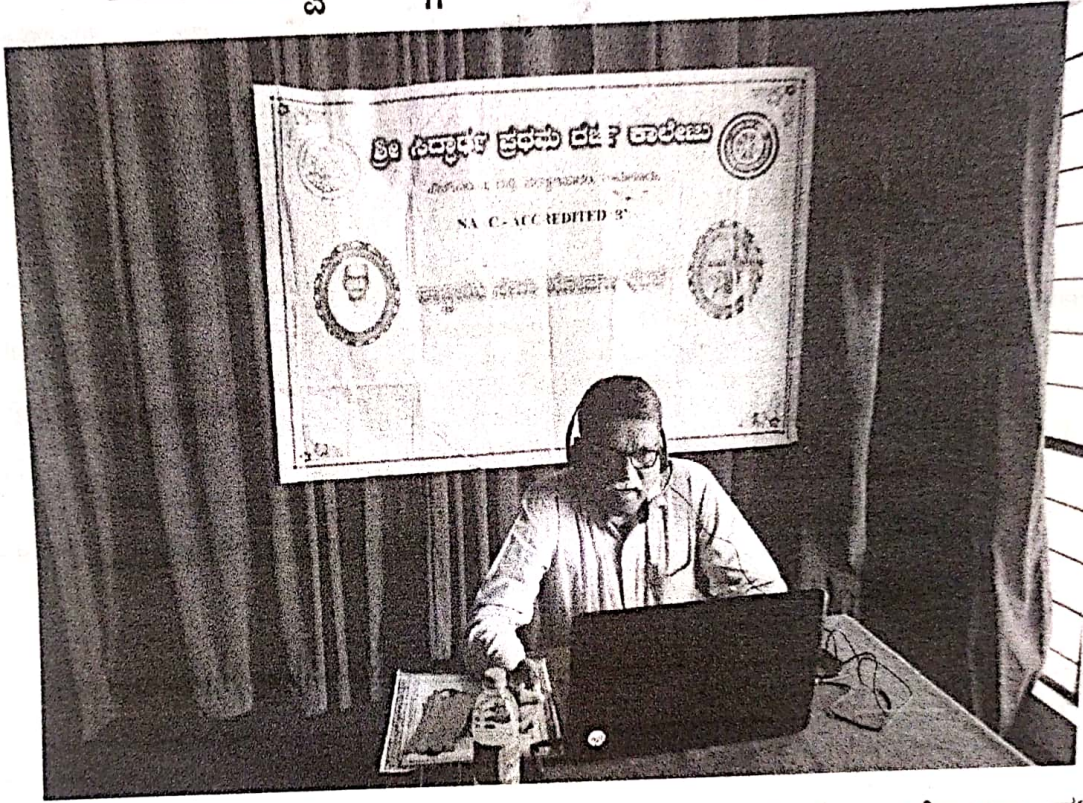

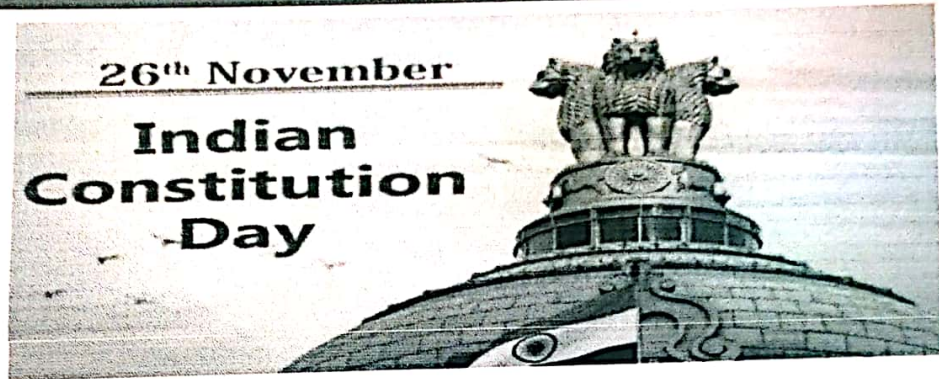

The formal function commenced by the warm inaugural welcome conducted by the Prof.DR.Rangaswami.



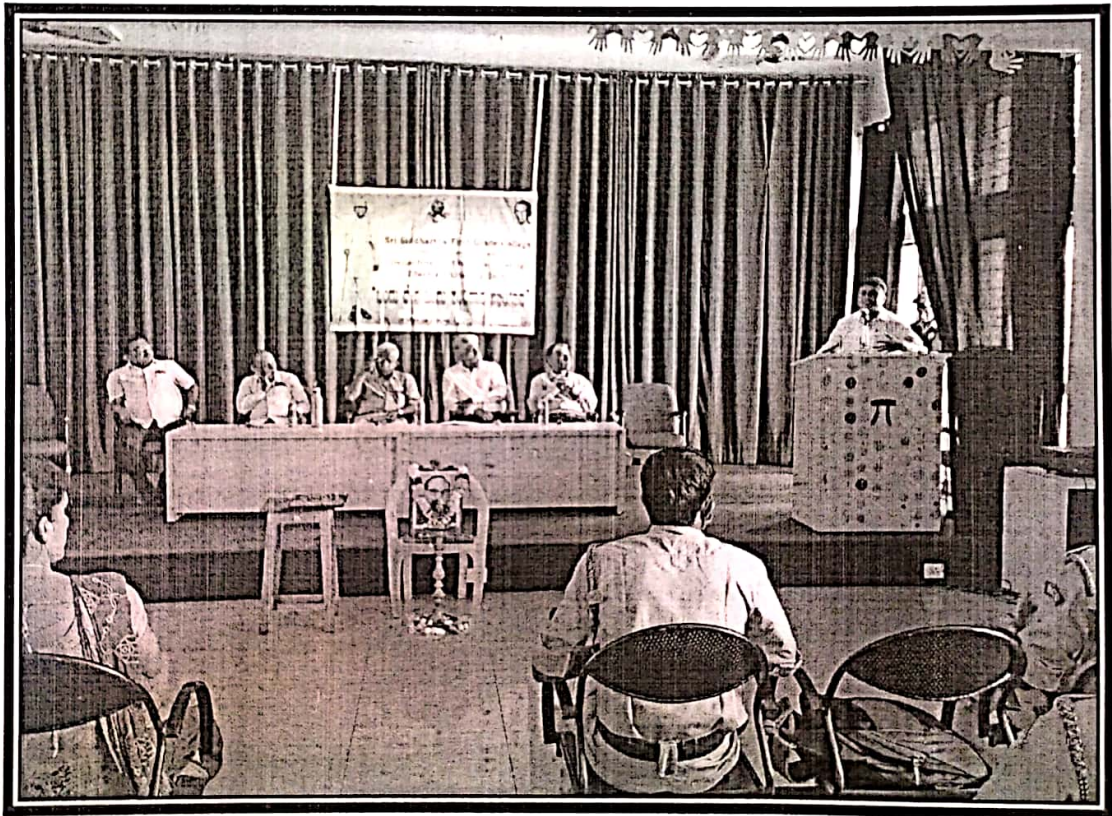

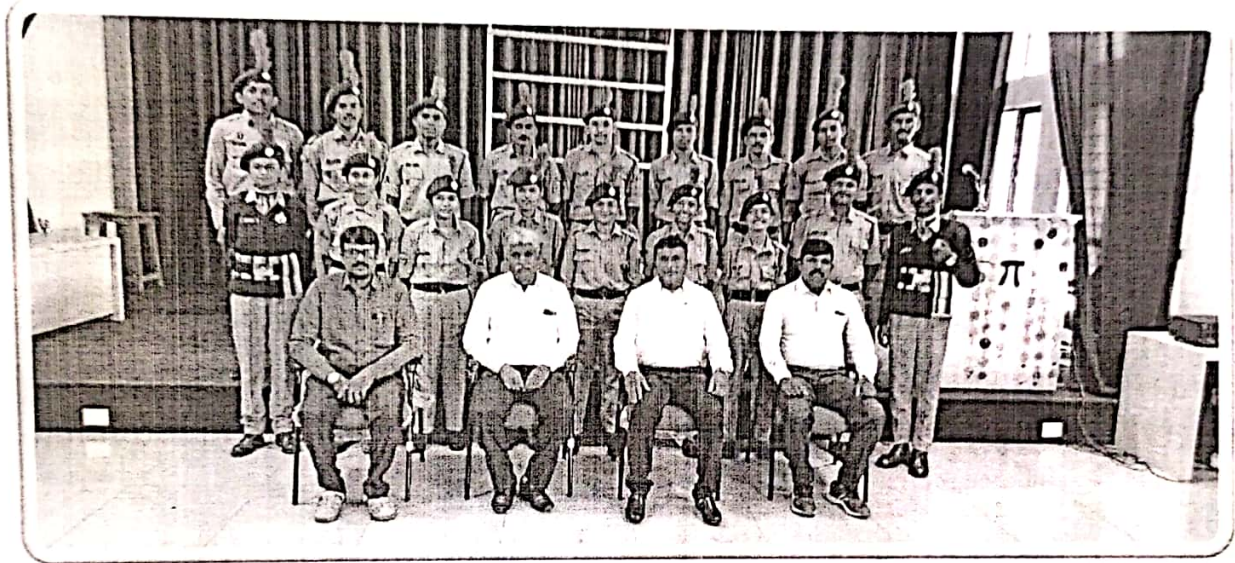
